

MEALS OF HOPE

MAC & CHEESE MEAL PACKING EVENT

- Started in 2007 in Naples, Florida, Meals of Hope is a non-profit organization with the goal to package and distribute fortified meals to those in need.
- Locally, Summit Rotary of Greensboro purchased equipment to accommodate a 100 person meal packing, assembly line event that produces approximately 50,000 fortified dried macaroni and cheese meals (6 meals/bag) at one 2-hour event.
- Fortified meals include macaroni, soy protein, 21 vitamins and minerals, packet of cheese sauce.
- Over the last eight years, this event has packed nearly 800,000 meals. In 2019, 80,000 meals were packed by 160-plus Rotary members, families, and friends. Nine Rotary clubs and 14 Interact and Rotaract student clubs participated.
- For 18.5 cents per meal you can choose where the meals go. Given that 57% of the 73,000 students in the Greensboro Guilford County public schools receive subsidized lunches, Summit Rotary has partnered with the non-profit "**The Out of the Garden Project**" that provides food for food insecure students on weekends. Meals will also go to local food pantries.
- Both **Meals of Hope** and the **Summit Rotary Foundation** are non-profit, 501 c3 organizations so all donations are tax deductible.
